DAY 1

As you discuss this, consider the related scriptures to make sure you are rightly dividing the word of truth.

DAY 4

Praise is defined as an expression of admiration or appreciation. Praise is essentially a response to God, who meets us through revelation. In praise, we reflect back to God that which he has revealed to us about himself, with expressions of our admiration and appreciation. Praise may be expressed in private prayer or public worship, in words or in songs.
